Recently, a fellow worker with LWI commented that regardless of our plans, at the moment the flight attendant closes the doors to the aircraft, God takes over. Perhaps the truth is, our best laid plans don't really go astray, but rather God's plan begins to unfold before us.

With that in mind I want to give you an opportunity to rejoice with me in what He has already done and rejoice in what He is about to do.

Since I last wrote to you,

- My permit to become a Tanzanian resident has been approved.
- A Tanzanian non-profit NGO (non-government organization) has been registered for the purpose of conducting water projects free of duty and taxation.
- A 20' container of pumps and supplies was shipped to a port at Dar es Salaam, TZ
- A friendship which began in January 2002 with a Tanzanian has developed into a ministry partnership. This man, Mendrad Kigola, has become my eyes and ears in the southern districts and is most helpful in sighting new project location. He has also been doing all of the leg-work necessary to get the various government certifications and documents in order to further the ministry of LWI and "Hannah's Hope".

I am preparing to leave for Tanzania on April 6<sup>th</sup> with a planned return date of May 4<sup>th</sup>. There are many things surfacing to be done, all of which I am asking you to pray for.

- Successful drilling projects in the villages of,
  1. Simbay
  2. Gidika
  3. Dang'Aida
  4. Jorodom
  
- Productive meeting with a drilling contractor.
- Clearing the container shipment through customs and trucking it inland to Katesh.
- Travel to the southern districts to conduct the first NGO meeting.
- Introductions to District and village leadership in southern Tanzania.
- The development of new drilling and well rehabilitaion projects.

And that through all of this, people might hear and receive the message of Hope that God has provided through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Water is not the goal....it is simply the tool.
